

The SECURE Act 2.0 has introduced significant changes to retirement benefits, particularly concerning required minimum distributions (RMDs) and the Social Security Fairness Act. Here are the key updates:

RMD Age Increase: The age for RMDs has risen to 73, with a further increase to 75 starting in 2033. This change allows savers to compound their money for a longer period before withdrawal.

Social Security Fairness Act: The Act ends the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and Government Pension Offset (GPO), increasing Social Security benefits for certain workers. Beneficiaries will receive a one-time payment to cover the increase in their benefit amount back to January 2024. These changes are part of a broader effort to enhance retirement savings and benefits for savers and retirees. It is essential for individuals to stay informed about these updates and their implications for their retirement planning.

Major Social Security Changes Coming in October 2025: What Retirees Must Know - October 15 will be a pivotal date for the 67 million Americans who depend on Social Security (SS). On this day, the government will announce new figures that will define monthly benefit adjustments, tax thresholds, and retirement age rules for 2026. While President Trump's agenda emphasizes "protecting" Social Security without cutting benefits or raising the retirement age, upcoming 2026 adjustments reflect broader economic realities and regulatory updates that retirees and future beneficiaries must closely monitor.

The Reality Behind the 2026 Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) - Experts project a 2026 COLA increase of about 2.7%, aimed at keeping benefits aligned with inflation. For the average retiree, this equals around \$54 more per month or roughly \$650 over the year. However, rising Medicare Part B premiums are expected to absorb much of this gain. With premiums projected to rise by over 11% (about \$26.50 more monthly), nearly 40% of the COLA increase could vanish, leaving many retirees with just \$32 extra per month on average. Critics argue that the current COLA formula — based on the CPI-W, which tracks urban wage earners — fails to reflect the true cost increases seniors face, especially in healthcare and housing.
