Commander's Message



Membership – New Cards – The 2025 cards are in at the Department of Georgia and the post will be processing membership for 2025 as soon as the cards have been delivered to the Post. Remember the Post Dues is now at \$45.00 per member. Any dues received short will be held until full payment has been received. The renewal notices should signify the change in the Post dues.

Post Installation of Officers – All personnel attending should be comfortable wearing legion casual attire for the weather. No shorts, sandals or flip flops. Each organization officers should have a theme tee shirt or polar type, of that organization worn to identify that organization to be install. Most important, wear your organizational cap when being installed.

American Legion News – Effective July 1, The American Legion's national per-capita dues will increase from \$18.50 to \$23.50. The 11th District and Department of Georgia did not raise their dues for the upcoming year but will in 2026. This means National is \$23.50, the Department and District is \$11.50 and Post 178 maintains theirs at \$10; bringing up the Post renewal rate of being **\$45.00** total.

What you need to know about a multiyear membership: 1. The three-year membership sign-up is only available on the national American Legion website (legion.org/renew and legion.org/join). Current or potential members cannot renew or join for a three-year membership at the post level or through MyLegion.org.

2. Payment for the three-year membership is upfront. 3. There is not a discounted rate with the three-year membership. 4. Membership cards will still be sent annually by Legion posts. 5. Those who sign up for a multiyear membership will not receive a renewal notice during the time they have signed up for the multiyear membership.
