Patriotic Observance – FEBRUARY 2024 - Black History Month

The origins of Black History Month came from Carter G. Woodson, considered the "Father of Black History." Woodson dedicated his life as a Harvard scholar of African American studies to push Black history to the forefront of public knowledge.

In 1915, Woodson founded the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (renamed Association for the Study of African American Life and History.) The organization's purpose was to research and publicize the successes of many Black Americans and people with African ancestry.

A. National Salute to Veteran Patients February 11th - The purpose of the National Salute to Veteran Patients Program is to pay tribute and express appreciation to Veterans, increase community awareness of the role of the VA medical center and encourage citizens to visit hospitalized Veterans, and to become involved as volunteers.

B. Valentine's Day Feb 14th - Valentine's Day, also known as St. Valentine's Day, is celebrated each year in America on Feb. 14th, a time when couples show their love for one another with greeting cards, romantic gifts, and outings.

C. **Coast Guard Reserve Birthday Feb 19th** - Feb. 19 is the official birthday of the United States Coast Guard Reserve. Officially set-up in the late 1930s as a "civilian reserve" operation, it was non-military in nature. The Coast Guard Reserve Act of 1939 was the earliest incarnation. The Reserve soon evolved into something much greater than the original authors of the law had envisioned.

D. **President's Day Feb 19th** - Presidents' Day, officially Washington's Birthday at the federal governmental level, is a holiday in the United States celebrated on the third Monday of February. It is often celebrated to honor all those who served as presidents of the United States and, since 1879, has been the federal holiday honoring Founding Father George Washington, who led the Continental Army to victory in the American Revolutionary War, presided at the Constitutional Convention of 1787, and was the first U.S. president.
